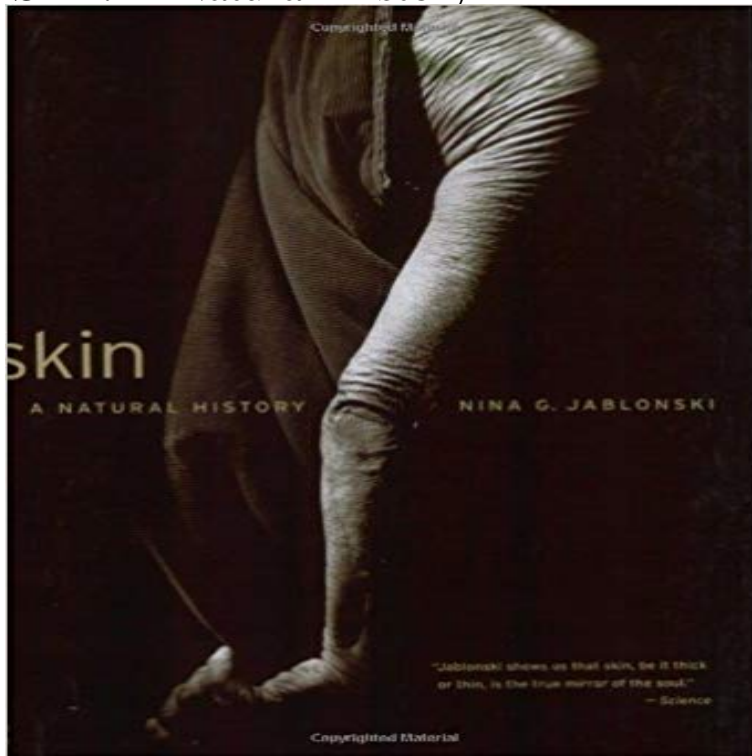


Skin: A Natural History
