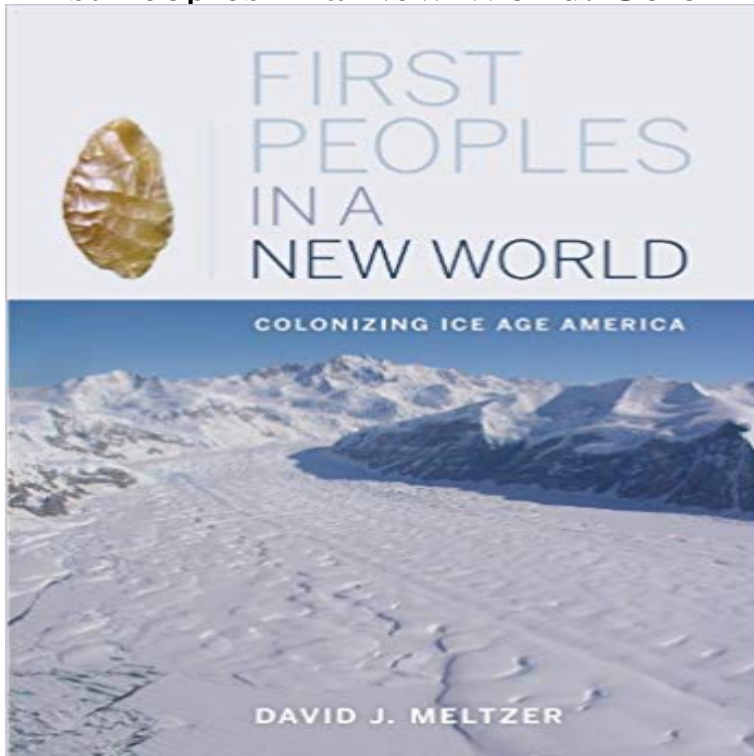


First Peoples in a New World: Colonizing Ice Age America
