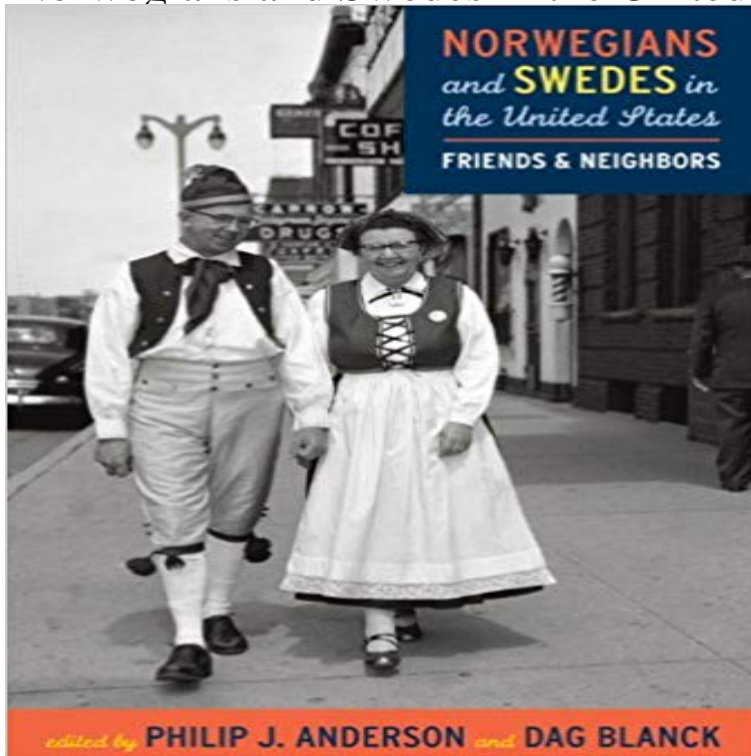


Norwegians and Swedes in the United States
